

## Form for transporting an assistance dog in the passenger cabin on flights outside the USA

Certified assistance dogs (assistance animals [SVAN] - e.g. guide dogs, assistance dogs for the deaf, diabetics, epileptics) can be taken into the passenger cabin free of charge on all flights operated by LOT Polish Airlines.

## Conditions for the carriage of a certified assistance dog in the passenger cabin:

- For safety reasons and to ensure that the flight runs smoothly, a certified assistance dog is trained to behave appropriately in public. In order to be allowed to travel with your certified assistance dog, it is necessary that the dog obediently responds to the commands of its owner and behaves appropriately (does not bark, growl or jump on people or other animals).
- The dog must not satisfy its physiological needs in the passenger cabin or in the gate area, unless this is done in a way that does not cause health risks to others or hygienic problems.
- On board the aircraft, the dog should sit or lie in the space under the preceding seat and be secured against
  disturbing fellow passengers by means of a harness or leash. For safety reasons, LOT Polish Airlines
  recommends passengers travelling with an assistance dog to carry a muzzle with them.
- In the event that the dog does not behave in an appropriate manner, LOT Polish Airlines may move the dog to the cargo hold for an additional charge or refuse its carriage. The owner of the dog will be held fully responsible for any damage caused by the assistance dog and any additional costs incurred as a result of the carriage.
- The passenger is obliged to hold all documents and to ensure that he/she complies with the regulations for the transport of animals in the country of departure and arrival.
- In the event that LOT Polish Airlines identifies a breach of the abovementioned conditions of carriage, the passenger will not be entitled to claim reimbursement of any costs incurred as a result of being denied boarding (e.g. booking fees, hotel charges or any costs associated with placing the dog in a shelter/hotel).
